Authoritarianism is a theory and a system of government customarily linked with dictatorship, in contrast to democracy It is a principle based on obedience to authority, and opposes autonomy of individuals in thought and action As a form of government, authoritarianism concentrates power in a leader or in a small elite not constitutionally
